

COLLEGE CONNECTIONS AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of August 9, 2013:

WHEREAS, the College is offering courses to your students through the College Connections program

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the College shall establish the context of the course and approve the instructor. The Program Partner will provide classroom space and reimburse the instructor.
2. College personnel will make a classroom visit for the purpose of evaluating the curriculum delivery, which includes securing and reviewing of student evaluations.
3. The Program Partner agrees to provide a minimum of 1.5 days of release time for each program teacher per year for the purpose of attending mandatory professional development meetings and workshops. If the College recognizes a pattern of absence over a two-year period, the program teacher will meet with program administrators to discuss future program participation.
4. Students enrolled in the course shall be students of the Program Partner and shall receive the appropriate number of credit hours from the college for completing each course.
5. The College shall charge the Pennsylvania State Program Partner a fee based upon the number of students participating, number of credit hours and any applicable fees (i.e. SLN fee for online courses, lab fees, etc) based upon the agreed upon payment model(attached).

Services provided by JCC include:

- a. Curriculum development and integration
 - b. Curriculum coordination and revision
 - c. Teacher/curriculum evaluation by JCC liaison
 - d. Student evaluation
 - e. Teacher in-service
 - f. Instructor (if applicable)
6. The Faculty Student Association (FSA) fee is waived by the College for all students. Accordingly, students have no free or reduced access to JCC gymnasium facilities and FSA events.
 7. Schools will be billed associated tuition and fees for students taking any course which contains a laboratory component (i.e. BIO 1570) held on a JCC campus.
 8. Students may obtain access to the JCC Library. Students are expected to follow the same guidelines for Library use as on-campus students. Those wishing to on-campus computer labs must pay the per-credit-hour college technology fee. This access will be established at the request of an instructor on a course-by-course basis.

9. Textbooks will be purchased by the school district or by the students as determined by the school district.
10. This agreement shall be subject to "*State University of New York Guidelines on Credit in High Schools.*"
11. School District hereby agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, defend (with counsel reasonably agreeable to the College), and release the College from and against all claims, demands and actions, or causes of action, for damage to personal property, personal injury, or death arising out of the alleged negligence of the School District, its agents or employees, to the extent permitted by Education Law 3023.
12. College hereby agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, defend (with counsel reasonably agreeable to the School District), and release the School District from and against all claims, demands and actions, or causes of action, for damage to personal property, personal injury, or death arising as a result of the acts of college personnel acting in the course of their employment.

Terms of the Contract:

1. The initial term of this Contract shall be from August 9, 2013 to July 31, 2018 and shall automatically renew annually for five (5) years thereafter unless terminated by either party upon six (6) months prior written notice. During the term of this Contract, the parties may make adjustments thereto by addendum. In the event that the Contract is terminated by either party, the termination shall in no way jeopardize the educational program of learners already participating in the educational programs. In the event that either party violates any part of this Contract, and does not correct the violation after ten (10) days written notice to do so, the other party may terminate this Contract upon notice. Any such termination for cause, however, shall not jeopardize the educational programs of learners already participating in the educational program.
2. This contract may be revised or modified by written amendment when both parties agree to such amendment
