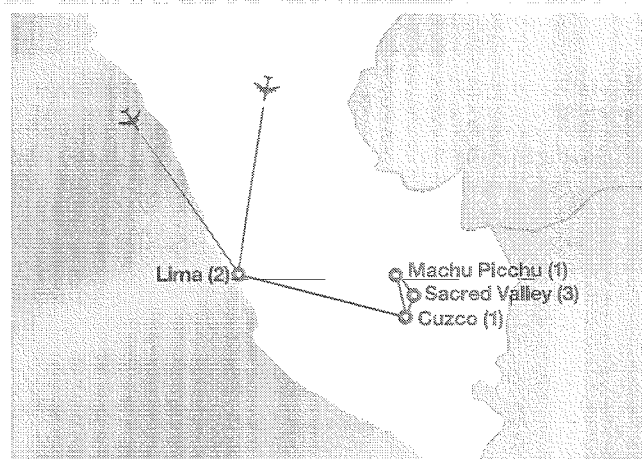

To give you an idea of what your experience may be like, here's a glimpse into a recent tour to Peru:

- Students, along with their teachers, visited a high mountain community in the **Chinchoero region**, worked with locals on agricultural activities and interacted with students and teachers for a full day at a local school
- The group visited the Larco Museum and three key Incan sites—**Sacsayhuaman**, **Ollantaytambo** and **Machu Picchu**—to learn about Peru's unique history
- At **Pablo Seminario's ceramic workshop**, the group learned about ancient techniques and modern investigations into working with local clay
- Students discovered how important weaving and textiles are in the community. First, they learned about traditional attire and the woven symbols. Then they worked with locals to **dye materials, spin wool and weave textiles**

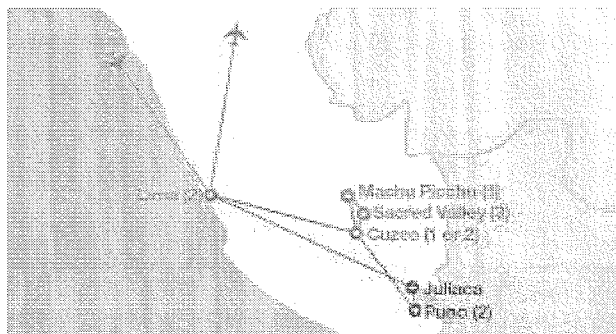
