3.3 Resolution Indicating WCSD's Intent to Accept QZAB Funds for WAHS

Discussion:

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The Warren County School District was notified on September 17, 2014 by the Pennsylvania Department of Education that they have been granted an allocation of \$8,449,000 from the 2013 Qualified Zone Academy Bond (QZAB) Program for work at Warren Area High School. A school board resolution confirming acceptance of QZAB funds must be received by PDE by October 3, 2014.

A conference call was held with Jamie Doyle, Public Financial Management (PFM). A conservative estimate has the WCSD benefiting/saving approximately \$2.8 million dollars with a QZAB loan versus a traditional loan.

At the request of the building inspector, the proposed concession stand will be handicapped accessible. There will be no cost to the District for this project.

3.7 YHS LED/Energy Analysis

Discussion:

The WCSD received the wrong color light poles at Sheffield Area MHS as part of the project there. To take the poles down, refinish them and replace them would be cost and time prohibitive. The contractor is suggesting that as an alternative they can provide 159 LED light fixtures for Youngsville High School. This concession will save the District approximately \$49,000.

That the Board of School Directors approves the proposal from Lighting Sale, Inc. of 159 LED light fixtures as a concession for the incorrect paint finish on the light poles at the Sheffield QZAB project.
