Any device that employs a heating element, battery, power source, 23 electronic circuit, or other electronic, chemical, or mechanical means, regardless of 24 shape or size and including the component parts and accessories thereto, that can be 25 used to deliver vaporized nicotine or other substances (that may or may not contain 26 nicotine) to users inhaling from the device. Examples of such devices include, but 27 are are not limited to, electronic cigarettes, electronic cigars, electronic cigarillos, 28 electronic pipes, electronic nicotine delivery systems, vape pens, personal 29 vaporizers, or any similar device. 30 31 2. Any substance intended for use with, or in, a device described in Section 1 32 of this definition, regardless of whether the substance contains nicotine. 33 34 For purposes of this policy, the term "vapor product" does not include any 35 substance or device that is regulated by the United States food and drug 36 administration under chapter V of the federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act. 37 38 The Board prohibits tobacco or vapor product use or visible possession (and 39 discourages any possession) by District employees, District volunteers, and 40 independent contractors performing a service for the District in a school building, 41 on school property, while working or performing a service at a school-sponsored 42 activity that is held off school property, or on any bus, van or vehicle that is owned, leased or controlled by the District, or utilized by a transportation contractor 43 44 to transport District students to or from school or a school sponsored activity. The 45 Board further prohibits tobacco or vapor product use (and discourages possession) by members of the general public in a school building, on school property, or on 46

10	refuses immediately cease the violation may be removed from school property and,
