# 3.1 Bid Results: Waste Disposal and Recycling Services Re-bid (WCSD #1404R)

# Discussion/Updates:

The Waste Disposal and Recycling Services contract for the WCSD was originally bid in November 2014 and re-bid in March 2015, resulting in approximately \$16,000 of cost savings to the District

Recommendation is for a five year contract to stabilize prices.

#### 4.2 AVES Generator to YEMS

# **Discussion/Updates:**

Youngsville Elementary/Middle School (YEMS) is currently without a back-up generator that would supply the building with emergency lighting, power for food refrigeration systems, etc. It is the desire of the Administration to investigate moving the back-up generator currently located at the former Allegheny Valley Elementary School (AVES) to YEMS. The District's sever farm located at AVES has its own generator, and would not be affected by this move.
