Course Title: Middle Level Band

Middle Level Band is a course in intermediate instrumental music techniques that meets one period each day. The course is open to all students in grades 6-8 who have level appropriate performance skills on a band instrument and have a desire to improve these skills both individually and in an ensemble setting.

Middle Level Band will present at least two performances per year. All performances will be scheduled and placed in the school calendar. Concerts are mandatory and will be part of the course grade. Absence from these performances will be allowed at the director's discretion.

The course places emphasis on personal improvement in instrumental music skills, and a performance schedule that provides opportunities for demonstration of the level of mastery achieved by the students. A final exam is not required.
