## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Course Title: Ensemble Choir
Course Number: 00862
Course Prerequisites: Previous Musical Experience, preferred
Course Description: (Include "no final exam" or "final exam required") The Ensemble Choir is an elective course open to students in grades 10 through 12. Emphasis is placed upon soprano and alto voices and vocal production (i.e. vocalists' breathing, posture and voice-placement or head tone). Sight-singing is taught on an almost daily basis. Students are encouraged to develop self-confidence in their own singing by singing in trios, quartets, etc., as well as with the large choir. The director also listens to students sing individually as a means of assessment.
The ensemble will sing in the Holiday and Spring concerts as well as various other performances in the community. Attendance is mandatory at all performances. Music is sung from memory and will consist of various styles. Final exam is required.
