3.8 Revised 2016-2017 School Calendar – Due to Strike

<u>Discussion:</u> Two revised calendars are posted and the Administration is recommending the first calendar option. Act 80 days cannot be counted as student days. The first option extends graduation by one week to June 16, 2016. The second option moves graduation to mid-week. The District has never done a calendar with graduation occurring mid-week. Graduation on a Friday would be smoother. The Thanksgiving break and Christmas break remain unchanged. The District has to honor contractual holidays that are in other employee contracts and agreements. The Administration is recommending that parent/teacher conferences be moved to the semester break. A member of the public asked if it is legal to use all the energy days to target the original graduation date. Ms. Stewart replied that it is legal if absolutely necessary. The revised calendar is structured to provide the students with some breaks and a definite graduation date. The member of the public asked if seniors could

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attend school on Saturdays to meet the original graduation date. Ms. Stewart responded that the state will allow the district to use three Saturdays for senior activities.
