## **Support for Student Trip to Puerto Rico**

<u>Grant Overview</u>: WCSD instructor Jewel Rozanski will be taking a group of students to Peru with several other adult chaperones. The trip will take place in the third week of June, 2017. At this time there are nineteen students enrolled for the trip. The itinerary will include San Juan, Old San Juan, El Yunque Rainforest, El Morro, Ponce, La Parguera, and Farjardo. Student will be exposed to a number of cultural and historic landmarks, and be expected to use their Spanish skills.

The cost per student is approximately \$2,300, and fundraisers will be held to help defray student costs. The request for support does not include a specific dollar amount, but is a request for assistance as the Foundation sees fit to provide. The Foundation has generously provided support to past overseas trips for students.

Amount of Award: Open-ended.

Due Date/Notification of Award: Due in mid-January. Notification by February 2017.

<u>Alternatives if not Awarded</u>: Students will need to raise additional funds for the trip.

Administrative Recommendation: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to submit a grant request to the Community Foundation for Warren County requesting financial assistance to support the planned student trip to Puerto Rico in June 2017.
