## The Rural and Low-Income School Grant Summary

<u>Grant Overview</u>: The Rural and Low-Income School (RLIS) Program addresses the needs of rural, low-income schools. The US Department of Education awards funds to the Pennsylvania Department of Education, who in turn award sub-grants to eligible LEAs based on a formula. The funds are for activities specified by statute, including:

- Parent Involvement activities
- Other activities governed by statue, including those approved in:
  - o Title I-A (Improving Basic Programs)
  - o Title II-A (Supporting Effective Instruction)
  - Title III (Language Instruction for English Learners and Immigrant Students)
  - Title IV-A (Student Support and Academic Enrichment)

The district proposes using the grant to purchase iRead educational software for use by district students.
