Hypertherm Educational Grant Summary

<u>Grant Overview</u>: The Hypertherm Educational Grant was established to help ensure that the next generation of metal working professionals is familiar with the newest technology for plasma cutting and gouging. The grant awards ten schools with a Powermax45 XP cutting system, AWS SENSE approved "Plasma Cutting Technology: Theory and Practice" curriculum kit, and an initial visit by a Hypertherm District Manager to set up and train on the equipment and curriculum.
