## 1. Opening Activities

## 1.1 Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:27 p.m. by Chairperson Mrs. Marcy Morgan.

#### **1.2 Public Comment**

Ms. Andrea Hillie, ANF Silviculturist, and Mr. Rich Hatfield, Bradford District Ranger, gave a presentation to the Committee regarding timbering in the Allegheny National Forest, specifically regarding the harvesting of the ash trees.

Ms. Hillie addressed the Bradford Ash Remediation project which was initiated in 2015 and approved in 2017. As a result of the project, nearly 4 million board feet of ash was offered for sale during the fiscal year of 2018. Not all of the ash sold by the ANF on the market has been cut yet.

Mr. Hatfield presented the Committee with information regarding the total amount of timber offered for sale on the ANF. According to the information provided, there has been an increase in both timber sales and timber cuts since 2009; however, the value of timber has decreased on the market, thereby affecting the profit realized.

Mr. Labesky questioned Ms. Hillie and Mr. Hatfield regarding the amount of ash being cut. Ms. Hillie shared that there are a number of factors affecting the total harvest possibility including: environmental limitations, economy of scale, accessibility and location (s) of trees.

Mr. Stewart offered to take the Forest Rangers through the ANF and share with them areas where there is ash readily available and easily accessible.

Mr. Hatfield closed the presentation by offering to look again and see if there are areas with high concentrations of ash which can be harvested.

## 3.1 Flagpole Discussion

#### Discussion:

Ms. Morgan shared with the Committee that she had received a request from the Eisenhower Elementary School to have a flagpole placed in front of the school. There is interest from the staff in having the students raise and lower the flag.
