4.0 Informational Items

4.1 Athletic Taskforce Report

<u>Discussion:</u> Mr. Weber presented a summary of the taskforce meetings. The taskforce was given the job of how to increase participation and of how to determine how and when to develop co-ops. Issues discussed in the meetings included motivating factors for playing, obstacles to participation, outcomes for co-op agreements, paying to participate, coaching education, safety, recruiting, lack of teacher coaches and the impact of travel teams.

One of the recommendations of the task force is that a program for 5th and 6th grade be created to introduce students to athletics within the District.

It is recommended that if a team has the minimum number to participate the team will be allowed to participate in their home school. If a coach asks to co-op, the District is not opposed to teams electing to co-op.

Mr. Joseph Colosimo suggested that the District consider consolidation into a district-wide team in the interest of safety and performance. A new team name, color, and mascot would be selected to reflect the district-wide team. He recommended that the District reach out to Clymer, Sherman and Panama to see how they have managed team consolidation.

Ms. Elizabeth Huffman expressed disagreement. She thinks that the District should continue to proceed in the direction that it has already chosen which is to follow the recommendations of the task force. To disregard the recommendations of the task force at this point would send the wrong message to everyone including the public.

Mr. Arthur Stewart expressed his appreciation to the task force team and the work that they did. He found the summary of the task force meetings to be illuminating on some things of which he was not aware. The Board still has work to do and has the responsibility to respond. He appreciates the recommendation of the task force to create a program for 5th and 6th grade students to introduce them to the athletic programs.

Mr. Joseph Colosimo asked if the equipment, specifically the helmets, are up to safety specifications. Mr. Rick Gignac responded that the helmets are recertified after every season.

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Once a helmet reaches 10 years of use, it is disposed of. The National Federation of High School Sports has guidelines that follow the recommendations of the National Operating Committee for Sports Equipment. The District only purchases helmets that meet these guidelines and requirements. Additionally the District is starting to use a new item called the halo guardian protective helmet which is a plastic device that fits over the helmet for added safety. The device can only be used during practice and not at games.
