

2019-20 TANF Grant for WCCC Co-Op Students

Grant Overview: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) monies are available each year to enhance workforce development funding and extend the availability of high-quality workforce development activities to low-income youth. Fundable activities include employment, educational experiences, and essential skills training in areas like financial literacy and time management.

The administration, working with the local TANF fund contractor, has developed a plan to pilot a paid work experience, funded by TANF, for Warren County Career Center students. Students will continue to be managed through the WCCC's Cooperative Education Program.

If successful, the administration will apply for additional funding in 2020-21 to run the program for a full school year.

Amount of Award: Determined by the number of eligible students with completed paperwork.

Due Date/Notification of Award: Immediately. Notification in early March 2020

Alternatives if not Awarded: Cooperative education students will continue with unpaid work experiences.

WCSD Resources Required: None.

Administrative Recommendation: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to submit an application for 2019-20 TANF Youth Development Program funds to provide paid work experiences to eligible cooperative education students at the Warren County Career Center for the remainder of 2019-20.
