COVID-19 Emergency School Nutrition Funding 2019-20

<u>Grant Overview</u>: GENYOUth is providing grants of up to \$3,000 per school to supply much-needed resources for meal distribution and delivery efforts to get food to students during COVID-19. From soft-sided coolers, bags and containers for individual servings, to protective gear for food service sanitation and safety, this equipment will help ensure our children continue to receive the nutritious meals they need.

Schools must participate in the National School Lunch Program, include at least one of the grades K-12, and be in a "brick and mortar" school building.

The administration proposes applications on behalf of Youngsville High School, Sheffield Area Middle High School, and Warren Area Elementary Center, to support costs related to safely serving student meals, providing adequate sanitation and personal protective equipment, and/or meal preparation/transportation.

Amount of Award: Up to \$3,000.00 per eligible building.

Due Date/Notification of Award: No due date listed.

<u>Alternatives if not Awarded</u>: The district will consider other sources for funding assistance as they become available.

WCSD Resources Required: None.

<u>Administrative Recommendation</u>: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to complete and submit GENYOUth COVID-19 Emergency School Nutrition Funding grants for Youngsville High School, Sheffield Area Middle High School, and Warren Area Elementary Center to support costs related to COVID-19 provision of student meals.
