Pennsylvania State laws says that contracts for under \$20,000 do not need to be advertised with a bid opening. The District received three quotes for the job; Rabe Environmental Systems, Scobell Company, and Wm.T. Spaeder. The District plans to utilize Scobell Company's Technician and Rabe Environemntal Systems Balancer for the job.
