Safe Schools Targeted Grant 2019-20

<u>Grant Overview</u>: The Pennsylvania Department of Education is providing Safe Schools Competitive Targeted Grants for Equipment to address school safety and violence. Funding up to \$20,000 is available for eligible equipment, including but not limited to:

- Metal detectors
- Protective lighting
- Surveillance equipment
- Special emergency communications equipment including radios
- Electronic locksets, deadbolts and theft control devices and training in the use of the security-related technology; and,
- Student, staff and visitor swipe-card identification systems.

The administration proposes a request of \$7,900 for the purchase of:

- Two (2) training manikins with would emulation kits to enhance the annual multiagency drill that takes places each summer with the district's various first responder partners, and
- Two (2) Stop The Bleed training kits to allow district staff to effectively train district staff and a number of WCSD secondary students in the use of the Stop The Bleed kits found in all district buildings.

Amount of Award: \$7,900.00

<u>Due Date/Notification of Award</u>: Application due on August 18, 2020. Notification in November/December 2020.

<u>Alternatives if not Awarded</u>: Continue drills with existing resources. Find alternative funds/resources to provide Stop The Bleed training.

WCSD Resources Required: None.

<u>Administrative Recommendation</u>: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to develop and submit a Safe Schools Targeted Grant in the amount of \$7,900 to purchase safety training items to improve training efforts and enhance safety in the district.
