#### 3. Superintendent's Reports and Recommendations

- 3.1 General Comments Mrs. Amy Stewart
  - Mrs. Stewart announced the District received its Certificate of Occupancy for the front part of the WCCC, and the Virtual Academy is now in there. After school concludes, she will schedule another tour for board members to see the finished facility.
  - More guidance is coming regarding end of year activities. The inside capacity is still set at twenty-five percent, and outdoor capacity is fifty percent. Many questions are coming in from parents regarding graduation, and administration is still working on it with no definitive answers at this point. All schools are looking at graduation ceremonies outside at their respective football fields. It is concerning because weather is a factor.
  - There is a parent survey out and twenty-five percent (1,015) of the parents have responded. Eighty-eight percent of those who have responded said they will send their students back to school in the 2021-2022 school year.
  - COVID cases are going up following Easter activities. The District has zero employees out.

- Last year at this time the District was in crisis mode due to the emergency closing, and administration did not know what to do with the budget. Again, at this time, there are still lot of unknowns, but Mrs. Stewart and Mr. Grosch will do their best to present a budget for the board's consideration.
