3. Superintendent's Reports and Recommendations

- 3.1 General Comments Mrs. Amy Stewart
 - Mrs. Stewart shared that a gentleman from California sent a postcard of the Warren, PA Central High School from 1909 which he found in an antique shop.

- The All-County Musical was a great success with many positive comments. The final report will be coming to the Board at a later date.
- PSBA sent its *State of Education Report,* and a copy was given to each Board member. On page 4 the biggest challenges are finding teachers and having enough substitute teachers to cover classes. Districts are also facing shortages with classroom aides and bus drivers.
- Mental Health, attendance, and managing ESSER dollars are the top three items administration is concentrating on currently.
- Mrs. Stewart is working on facility planner interviews for the Board.
- On Friday, Mrs. Stewart attended the PASA Northwest Superintendents' Summit where Mark DiRocco shared data that will help with budgets and negotiations. She asked the Board members to watch their email for information coming from the PASA, PASBO, and PSBA regarding bills coming before the legislature that districts need to pay attention to, including two Right-to-Know bills that would be a great relief for school districts.
- Mandate Waivers are back on the table in the legislature, and they could help districts tremendously. When they were available, the WCSD utilized them in the early 2000's, but waivers were later discontinued.
- Mrs. Stewart report 160 superintendent positions out of 500 have turned over this year, which is significant. In addition, the following stats give reason for the teacher shortage districts are experiencing, in the 2010-2011 academic year Pennsylvania granted 21,045 new educational certificates, by 2019-2020 the figure dropped to just below 7,000, a 67 percent decline.
- For the first time US Department of Ed maintains a list of teacher shortages by subject area and for the first time ever, elementary education teachers are on the list from a national perspective. These issues are not just WCSD issues but nationwide. People with bachelor's degrees in Warren County is about 19 percent, while statewide it is 30 percent. In order to get a teaching certificate, you must have the bachelor's degree, therefore the district is in an uphill battle to get people in the pipeline for certificates.
- Eric Mineweaser and Chris Byham have been in discussions about what to do with AEDY. There are a lot of drug and alcohol infractions within the schools. The district is looking for some more creative solutions.
