- 3.1 General Comments Mrs. Amy Stewart
 - Mrs. Stewart reported the IU has started an initiative for all IU high schools to promote public education and to promote district students. This involves 10th through 12th grades, and students will be nominated each month, calling it "Class Act Emerging Leaders." WCSD will get one nomination, but all district high schools will nominate students to Mrs. Stewart, and she will forward one nomination to the IU. This will begin in October. Students will be featured through Erie media outlets.
 - Within the last set of allocation grants received by the district, along with the 2022-2023 budget, there are allocations for student mental health and safety. It was structured with tiers of services, and the monies are meant to fill the gaps. The district's services are in great shape, and the Board is to be commended for allocating dollars to support students.
 - Mrs. Stewart shared that she is receiving positive feedback regarding the opening of school, and positive feedback on the new principal assignments. It takes a lot of work to start school, and she thanked everyone, from HR staff to custodial staff to technology staff for the heavy lifting, because it was no small feat. Teachers are happy to be back to a normal school year.
 - On Thursday night the district is sponsoring "The Tall Cop" to talk about unhealthy behaviors students are engaging in. It will be held at Warren Area High School on the evening of the Open House.
