3.1 General Comments - Mrs. Amy Stewart

Mrs. Stewart introduced Jon Thomas, consultant for the facilities capacity study.

- 3.2 Jon Thomas Review of Capacity Reports
 - Mr. Thomas explained the process used in the capacity reports and data findings.
 - He then reviewed the summary sheet for all departments per school. Unscheduled rooms were not included in the analysis. The goal was to get the baseline utilization rates for each secondary school. He reviewed the percentages for each school: Eisenhower 60%; Sheffield 29.75%; Youngsville 37%; Warren Area High School 51%.
 - He reviewed scenarios comparing utilization. The District total, without unused spaces, is at 55% utilization. This means there are opportunities to look at reconfiguration to raise the utilization rate.
 - The District is looking for ways to get students to the staff to offer more diverse courses and offer more opportunities.
 - Elementary is not the focus, but he wanted the Board to see the elementary capacity reports. The District elementary capacity is at 80%.
 - At a subsequent meeting, Mr. Thomas will be presenting options with several different utilization scenarios with and without unused spaces.
