  - Mrs. Stewart highlighted an article she sent to the board members from Pennsylvania Association of Rural and Small Schools (PARSS) regarding the teacher shortage. The study is out of Penn State and how small and rural schools are suffering to a greater extent from the teacher shortage. The problem is national in scope. Elementary is on the needs list for the first time, which is unheard of. There are suggestions about what can be done to offer incentives to entice more people to go into the profession. Administration will also be looking at offering an early childhood education program at the WCCC to get interested students started early on an education pathway.
  - Mrs. Stewart stated that the administration owes reports to the Board on the therapy dogs, student data, and the impact of the pandemic.
    - Mr. Dougherty asked for an additional report on the snack offerings for students.
      - Mrs. Stewart reported a survey went out at Halloween asking parents what they are most comfortable with, and administration will send a survey again for the Christmas season.
