- 3. Career Center Advisory Mrs. Donna Zariczny

  - The Warren County Career Center has applied for grants through Cummings and PDE Supplemental. They have not heard on either of those yet.

  - The General Advisory Committees met on September 21st and attendance was lower than normal, but the meeting went well.

  - The Automotive Technology Program worked on their first hybrid project and the focus of the lesson was safety related in working with hybrids.
  - There will 100 students attending Manufacturing Day in Erie on October 11<sup>th</sup>.

- 3.1 General Comments Mrs. Amy Stewart
  - Mrs. Stewart distributed the new District Fact Sheet for 2023-2024. The overall enrollment number is 3,864 students. The Free and Reduced Lunch percentage is 53% as we track those that are eligible, but everyone in the district gets a free lunch. The EL is 1%; Gifted is 2%; Special Ed is up at 24% these numbers drive what students need in terms of support. These numbers help drive Title funding and Erate funding. Homeless numbers have changed because of a change in the definition. Transportation is a big challenge. The WCCC has added Early Childhood Development this year. The number of employees is listed. The general budget will look different next year without the influx of ESSR dollars.

- Mr. Vincent at Warren Area High School has a request that he has identified noting
  that students going back to Sheffield Area Middle High School do not have the same
  access to Math or Language Arts help when they go back for the afternoon. So he
  has asked if administration and the Board can find someone to do Math and English
  tutoring in the afternoon at Sheffield.
