1.6 Public Comment

Julia Foster	Russell	Mrs. Julia Foster announced to the board she is the wife of Mr. Scott Foster, a teacher and coach at Eisenhower Middle/High School. She explained the situation Mr. Foster is being put in for lack of evidence and findings is disappointing. She further explained her husband is a hardworking, caring teacher and wonders why the district would take him out of the school. Mrs. Foster asked if the board would let the accusations by a student "fly" and inquired whether the student has been helped. She explained they are a one income household with four children, and she would never let her children act this way. She explained there is a meeting on November 20 th to determine dismissal and they have received no other communication from the district. She is disappointed in the lack of respect shown to her husband. Mrs. Foster explained parents and the community would like communication, trust, and transparency from the board. Solicitor Byham advised the board to not comment on this personnel matter as it could come to the board for a board level hearing.
Jessica McGuire	Warren	Ms. Jessica McGuire informed the board she is a parent of a 6 th and 7 th grader at Beaty Warren Middle School. She was encouraged to attend the school board meeting by a teacher she met with during parent teacher conference due to her concerns with student behavior at Beaty Warren Middle School. She has learned from her children and fellow parents there is a lot of disruption during class with unruly students and their behavior. She explained she has known a lot of people to leave the district without even trying to fix the problem because of the behavioral issues at school. She has been surprised to learn of so many things her children have been exposed to such as cutting, depression, and suicidal thoughts that she did not expect in the Warren County School District. 2.3 Announcements

Mr. Mangione thanked the outgoing board members for their years of service. He expressed his pleasure working with them and getting to know each one of them and their attributions to the board table. He is proud to have served them as President and being able to get many things accomplished over the years. Mrs. Amy Stewart explained there has been a lot of important work done over the years. She acknowledged the years of all the board members: Cody Brown, two years; Jeffery Doughtery, two years; Kevin Lindvay, four years; Paul Mangione, ten years; Marcy Morgan, ten years; Mary Passinger, six years; Joseph Colosimo, eight years; Donna Zariczny, sixteen years; and Arthur Stewart, sixteen years. She explained the board members spend a lot of time together including board meetings, committee meetings, focus groups, negotiations, goal settings, board evaluations, and athletic events. Mrs. Stewart described being a board member as a job that never stops due to answering phone calls, responding to emails and social media, and overall defending their positions to members of the public. She said it takes an ethical approach and integrity. She feels blessed to have been a part of the 'Team of Ten' and all the knowledge and expertise the board members contribute. Mrs. Stewart explained moving forward with the new board members, it needs to be understood this is a big job within a big organization with a large budget, 650 employees, supporting over 3,000 students. Our buses travel over 10,000 miles a day while operating four attendance areas and a career center. She explained these are difficult times with population decreasing, enrollment decreasing, labor force decreasing, state dollars decreasing while poverty and expenses are increasing. She feels the board is handing off a school district that is responsibly run and in 'good shape'. She explained a safety department has been developed which has added safety and security measures throughout the district along with a collaboration with Law Enforcement and other emergency agencies throughout the county. The board has worked to continue to add Dual Enrollment opportunities for the students, developed STEM programs, evolved WCCC programming, and the Virtual Academy program. The Office of Pupil Services has worked with the board to get additional mental health support throughout the district including school psychologists, social workers, support dogs, and the STRIVE program. She explained prior to 2012, the district was taking out loans to be able to make payroll. After hiring the Director of Business Services, Mr. Jim Grosch, the district now has a budget that is fiscally responsible. Technology has advanced with one-to-one devices for students and broadband networking added throughout the county due the support of the board. Goals set by the board are what help administration make grant work successful which include the \$32 million in grants currently in progress such as afterschool programming, supporting tutors, class size reduction, and food service equipment. Mrs. Stewart expressed appreciation on behalf of herself and all of administration and hopes the board feels the reward of all their hard work.

She would like to bring a motion forward to the November 20th Special Board Meeting to appoint the interim superintendent.
