## 9115 Pilot Programs

The Superintendent or his/her designee may conduct pilot programs as they are deemed to be necessary to the continuing growth of the instructional program. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall report to the Board in writing each pilot program. This report shall be placed on file at each appropriate building site and at the central office. Included in this report are the program's objectives, evaluative criteria and projected costs. This report should be on file before the program is initiated.

The Board encourages, where it is feasible and in the best interest of the teachers of the District, participation in state-initiated pilot programs of educational research.

Parents have the right to exclude their children from research studies or surveys conducted by outside entities.
