<u>Grant Overview</u>: Title I is a 100% federally funded supplemental education program that helps local educational agencies improve educational opportunities for educationally deprived children. Title I programs are designed to help children meet the state content and performance standards in reading, language arts, and mathematics.

The Pennsylvania Department of Education has released preliminary Title I allocations of \$1,365,843.

All district elementary buildings should be eligible for Title I services in 2017-18. The administration is planning on a school-wide Title I application for 2017-18, and has been working with building teams to develop plans and strategies for use with the funding.

Amount of Award: preliminary allocation \$1,365,843

<u>Due Date/Notification of Award</u>: Due July 1, 2017.

<u>Alternatives if not Awarded</u>: This is a formula grant. Funds are awarded upon successful completion of the district application.

<u>WCSD Resources Required</u>: The district uses Title I funding to provide administrative oversight and clerical support for Title programming.

<u>Administrative Recommendation</u>: That the Board of School Directors instructs the administration to develop and submit a Title I, Part A application to the Pennsylvania Department of Education to provide educational support to eligible students in the Warren County School District for the 2017-18 school year.
