Career Readiness Mini-Grant Summary

<u>Grant Overview</u>: The mini-grant funds activities that support the district K-12 school counseling and career services plans, as required under state regulation Chapter 339. The district has proposed a career exploration project for eighth graders during advisory. Working with Warren-Forest School To Work, students would use online resources to complete interest assessments. Results from the assessments will be used to schedule student visits in applicable job clusters with the intent of creating and maintaining an individualized career plan. The grant will build on the same grant received in 2017-18.

Amount of Award: \$5,000.
